The Oceania Gymnastics Union has the pleasure to invite your Federation to participate in our 2026 AER Virtual Competition. Athletes may participate in the event as representatives of a club, school or their affiliated Federation.

LOCATION	Virtual
DATE	Entries are open from 14 th August to 18 th September 2026.
APPARATUS	Clear space as per division rules (FIG apparatus is not required). The routine must be filmed in a space with a square of the appropriate size marked out using tape/cones. The entire square must be visible for the whole routine. The music must be clear and the video of good quality. Entries that don't meet this requirement will not be judged and marked as DNS (Did Not Start) on the results. Filmed routines from another competition cannot be used.

FEDERATIONS INVITED	The Oceania Gymnastics Union invites all Oceania Member Federations (and their member clubs/schools) in good standing with the FIG & relevant MF.
EVENT DIVISIONS	Divisions for this competition will following the below programs: • Australian AeroSchools Manual • Australian Levels Program Rules 2026 & Beyond • FIG AER Code of Points 2025-2028
JUDGES	Federations/clubs are not required to provide a judge for the event; The Oceania Gymnastics Union will select judges for this event.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES	Routine videos must be uploaded between the 14 th August & 18 th September 2026. It will not be possible to submit videos prior to the 14 th August or after 18 th September.
ENTRY FEES	AU\$30.00 for each routine from Non-Emerging MF's. AU\$20.00 for each routine from Emerging MF's.
ENTRY NUMBERS	There is no limit to the number of routines an athlete, club or MF can enter; however, athletes may only enter one routine per category (i.e. an athlete in a multiple cannot enter a pair and trio routine).
CANCELLATION POLICY	Refunds will not be provided under any circumstance.
PAYMENT INFORMATION	Payment for each video must be paid for at the time of entry through the OGU website. Instructions for submission will be sent after payment has been received.
MARKETING	All marketing and media related enquiries should be directed towards marketing@oceaniagymnastics.org .
AWARDS	Medals will be awarded to 1st, 2nd and 3rd overall placings in each category. Ribbons are awarded to 4th, 5th and 6th. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings from each Emerging MF (ASA, COK, FIJ, GUM, PNG, TON) will also be awarded ribbons. The 1st, 2nd and 3rd placings in AeroSchools will be awarded ribbons. A cash prize of AU\$100 (per routine) will also be awarded to the top scoring routine in the following divisions: • Senior International Individual Women • Senior International Individual Men • Senior International Mixed Pair • Senior Trio • Senior Group • Senior Aerobic Dance There must be more than three entries in the category to qualify for the cash prize. Prizes packs will be available for schools and clubs that participate in the event.
